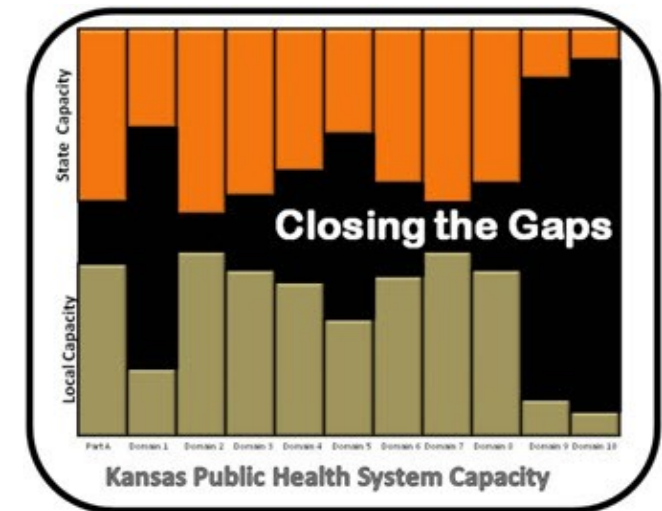

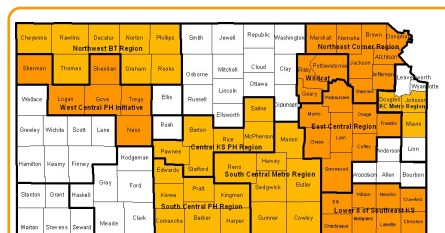
## Monday June 14, 2010
