Role in relation to HIE in Kansas

- Operational – support HIOs to take leadership role within their communities
 - Mandatory – ensure all providers have access to HIE
 - Optional – support standardized operational functions, i.e. common record locator system to all HIOs

Kansas Health Information Exchange, Inc.

To establish standards for approved HIOs to:

- Protect patients' interests
 - Opt out option
 - Privacy and security of PHI
 - Breach notification
 - Individual access to records through HIO
 - “Break the glass” procedures for emergency situations
- Protect providers' interests
 - Terms of provider participation agreements
 - User authorization and authentication
 - Data availability
 - HIO financial stability/sustainability
- Business Requirements
 - Governance
 - Compliance program
 - Public reporting

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Establish process to designate/oversee approved HIOs for:

- Application and review process
- Require third-party accreditation?
- Grievance procedures and corrective action plans

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Responsible for development and maintenance of Kansas HIE and ensuring privacy and security of information exchanged.

 - Reportable Diseases

 - Ability to pub out PH notices to providers

 - Reminder/recall functionality

Kansas Health Information Exchange, Inc.

- Progress of HIE in Kansas
 - Some vendors ready to test functionality of sending and receiving data
 - Policies not yet ready for approval of HIO's
 - Expect release of provisional criteria for HIO approval until policies are available
