

## WIC Data Reports

The WIC computer applications (KWIC) contain a large amount of data. Some reports within the system are valuable to local agency staff in their daily tasks (such as the appointment summary report, and interpreter report). Others are best suited to future planning or evaluation of productivity within the clinic setting. A few of the reports within the system are client specific and provide a history of actions taken with a given client or family group.

Attached are screen shots of KWIC report screens and examples of actual reports. A summary table of available KWIC reports which may be helpful in MCH initiatives is included. The summary table includes information regarding the availability of report data at the clinic, agency or statewide level. All reports used at the local level may be accessed through the State WIC Office.

In addition to reports generated through the KWIC system, we provide data to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention as part of the Pediatric Nutrition Surveillance System and Pregnancy Nutrition Surveillance System. We regularly receive reports about our aggregated data including information on height, weight, (overweight, underweight, short stature) hemoglobin status, TV and video viewing, vitamin and mineral supplementation, smoking and alcohol usage during pregnancy and postpartum periods, breastfeeding incidence and duration, mother's education level, race and ethnicity, and prenatal weight gain. These data reports are available at the state level with data available for each Kansas County. Samples of the 2006 state level data reports are enclosed.

We also have the capacity within the KWIC system to request from our contractor additional ad hoc reports for special projects or purposes. These must be requested through our KWIC Project Manager.
