Informatics Subcommittee Update – Michelle

The KALHD Informatics Subcommittee has continued work on the following projects. The biggest updates from the last meeting include:

- The subcommittee is still finalizing an informational update for LHDs on how to access and request additional information in regard to STI counts and rates from KDHE by county and region. This should be finalized soon.
- The final report for the January Informatics survey is being drafted and is on target to hit its end-of-June deadline. This report will help inform conversations and activities happing at the KALHD midyear regarding informatics session.
- Reminder: The KALHD Forum has a section for informatics related discussion. We will continue to remind folks to log in and spend some time reviewing and adding to the discussions.
- Remember to let Michelle and any subcommittee members know if there are questions or concerns with any Public Health information or systems that the subcommittee can discuss and possibly address.

KHI Public Health Exchange Program – Carlie Houchen

The program has been in place since 2014, and there have been seven exchanges with LHDs.

- identify future collaboration projects.

KDHE/CEI/KALHD Medicaid Workgroup

Questions for the group:

- 1. How could the MCO's work more effectively with Local Health Departments?
- 2. What do you want to see related to your work with MCO's?
- 3. If you could make changes to Medicaid as it relates to public health, what changes would you make?

Dan: United HealthCare information has not been shared with us. Michelle will check with them and report back.

Anne: We just never hear from them. Need more open communication.

Donna: I would like to see the billing be standardized between all three MCO's. All three have different billing "rules" to submit a claim for payment. For example, Birth Control - one will want an additional letter or number. Then the next time we will submit the same way and be denied. It is an ongoing game to get claims paid.

Rhonda: Getting claims confused with Medicaid and Home Health because it's the same Tax ID # but different NPI's.

Lynnette: I just completed the survey and had our Medical Biller help. She requests the patient eligibility screen show 'processing' or 'pending' when we put in the request. Then we can mark the patient for follow up.

Teresa: Fill the Medicaid gap.
