KDHE Update – Cristi Cain

- Governor's Public Health Conference Preconference Session is April 2. So far, 300 people have registered to attend this year's conference, and the adjoining hotel is full. There are other hotel nearby that have vacancies.
- Kan Be Healthy training will be live this year, and we hope to offer it online next year, in addition to a live session at future Governor's PH Conferences. The training content will be adjusted from year to year to meet the needs of PH staff. In order to make sure this training is valuable, LHD design team members work to identify content changes. There will also be a survey out soon that will help team members gather information to help move this project forward.
