Organizational Updates

• Sunflower Foundation Core Support Grant for SDoH

- Several months back I announced we applied for a \$30,000 core support grant open to organizations working on SDoH. We did not receive funding (we knew there were a lot of applicants but it seemed to be worth applying for).
- I am continuing to explore other opportunities with the Sunflower Foundation (more projectoriented work).

• Dane G. Hansen Foundation

- I've put in an application to this NW Kansas focused foundation for a continuing education grant.
- o If approved, KALHD would administer reimbursements to local health departments in this foundation's 26-county region for things like dues, workshop travel costs, etc.

• Health Forward Foundation

- I've put in an application to this foundation (focused on Allen, Johnson, and Wyandotte counties) for a core support grant.
- o My thanks to Lougene Marsh of Johnson County for providing a letter of support!
- This submission made the July 10th deadline. It may be two months before we hear back. Request was for \$50,000.

Audit

o KALHD's annual audit field work took place the week of July 1st.

Project Updates

PHEP

- KALHD signed a six-month extension to the prior PHEP contract so that services could be maintained while the new RFP was being put together.
- The KALHD-KDHE PHEP Advisory Team is assembled and the first meeting scheduled for August (the plan is to meet quarterly).

PHIT

- Jason Tiller is representing KALHD with this effort and attended the in-person meeting with the other participating states. I started to participate with the Kansas team (includes KDHE and CPHI).
- o It's to learn how to do systems thinking.
- o In Kansas we're tackling the challenge of why local health departments that prioritize behavioral health issues struggle to make progress.



Legislative Updates

• No legislative news. In August I think we'll want to constitute the Legislative Committee to decide what the platform in 2020 should look like.
