Executive Director Report June 16, 2021

Organizational Updates

- Mid-Year Meeting (MYM)
 - o As of 6/1/2021 we had 63 individuals registered for one or both days.

Project Updates

- Webinars on SB 40 and American Rescue Plan Funding
 - Sunflower opened this application to KALHD formally on 6/1/2021 and I submitted the documentation same-day.

Legislative Updates

- The 2021 session is over. Highlights:
 - o \$1 million added to the State Formula funding (should carry over into the future)
 - o \$12,000 minimum to the State Formula (just for SFY 2022)
 - Our bill (HB 2248) to permanently increase the minimum ended the session awaiting a full Senate vote. Progress carries over into 2022.
 - SB 40 passed adding new scenarios whereby local health officers require prior approval from county commissioners for certain orders
 - SB 13 passed, eliminating the tax lid on counties (commissions can now raise property taxes without going to a public vote)
 - Efforts to extend the COVID-19 Contact Tracing Privacy Act failed (KDHE still subject to similar provisions via budget proviso but local governments no longer under the act as it expired)
 - Efforts on anti-vaccine bills did not fully advance but live on for next year (namely a bill to mandate school/day care vaccination requirements be in statute not regulation and limiting employers from taking adverse employment actions to employees over vaccination status)
