
Workshop Popularity (determined by highest percentage of Strongly Agree+Agree versus the Total less any N/A results):


- Most popular meal: The Day 2 hot breakfast buffet (average 4.38 stars out of 5)

- 95.35% of respondents strongly agreed or agreed that "I would recommend MYM attendance to others"


Q1 Did you attend (in whole or in part) Day 1 of the KALHD MYM: Tuesday, June 15, 2021?






Q3 Positioning Your Health Department as Chief Health Strategist




Q5 Kansas Health Matters - How Can This Tool Help You?




Q6 Addressing the Drivers of Health to Create Healthy Communities: What's Being Done and What Opportunities Exist for Kansas Local Health Departments?







Q7 How would you rate the breakfast (Continental Buffet)?





Q9 How would you rate the snack (Hummus & Veggies)?








Q11 Did you attend (in whole or in part) Day 2 of the KALHD MYM: Wednesday, June 16, 2021?




