Organizational Updates

- Shelby Ostrom
 - Started on October 11th
- 2022 MYM
 - O Put in a request for a written contract copy (we have an email stating we are confirmed for the next three years in Salina but I didn't get anything more formal)
- Region VII Academic Health Department Conference 2021
 - o I was asked to present on a panel relating to legislative challenges. Did that on October 15th.

Project Updates

- Immunization Provider Enhancement
 - o KIP requested a minor modification to the subcontract with KAC, this was made and we fully executed the agreement with KAC on October 12th
 - Turned in our first quarterly report at the start of the month, along with our first reimbursement request
 - With Shelby onboard now we'll start to do more work in getting information and resources out to the LHDs

• Webinars on SB 40 and American Rescue Plan Funding

- o ARPA webinar on September 24th was <u>very</u> well attended (over 120 attendees and we went over by 20 minutes trying to answer all the questions)
 - Sadly, the recording got corrupted by Zoom so that the audio ends up super fast and to my knowledge KAC was not able to get that fixed
- Planning for the SB 40 webinar is expected to begin after this KAC conference and likely will be conducted in November
