## **KIP Project Updates**

#### 1. Website Updates

Continuing to update the vaccination resources pages with new information as Kansas enters endemic footing. I am hopeful to transition a lot of the resources into a downloadable spreadsheet for easier access, similar to the IAC one.

#### 2. KIP Collaboration

KALHD and the Kansas Pharmacists Association are working with other Kansas vaccine providers on a survey to learn how to better collaborate. We are developing the survey and should have it out to LHDs sometime this spring.

#### 3. Immunizations Listserv

Encourage everyone to continue to utlize the immunizations listserv for questions and information, and make sure to check out the immunization update on Mondays. I am considering doing another survey this summer to assess it's continued effectiveness after pandemic footing has concluded.

## 4. Vaccine Hesitancy Resource Guide

Wanted to make another push for the resource guide on vaccine hesitancy. This guide will continue to be housed on KALHD's website, and will be updated yearly based on needs.
