Good morning,

Wanted to update this thread with information on the adolescent Novavax COVID-19 vaccine, which has now been approved for 12-to-17-year-olds. You may have seen the KS HAN alert that went out this morning and I assume more information will be shared tomorrow on the LHD update.

The current dosage recommendations for adults HAS NOT changed for adolescents. So, you can continue to order the Novavax vaccine from the KS vaccine website here: <https://kdhevaccineordering.myshopify.com/>. The bottle comes in a one vial of 10 doses.

Good morning:

I will be sharing this information in the immunizations newsletter coming out this week, but also wanted to

include a separate email with this information as well for you to bookmark.

As you may have heard, the Moderna 6-17 primary vaccine series was approved by the CDC/ACIP last Saturday. In addition, the “tender age” vaccines for both Moderna and Pfizer have also been approved. For your convenience, I have included a table below with the current vaccines and their age availability. ([it can also be found on the clinical considerations page here](#))

Please make note of the color cap changes. I recommend printing the below tables on poster paper and hanging in the office. KDHE anticipates that the 6-17 Moderna vaccine will be in provider offices by the end of this week. However, as a reminder, continue to order off of the KDHE vaccine site.
