
- Survey conducted this summer with KPha, KAAP, KHA, and KAFP.
- Review current relationships (see next slide)
- Focus on what as organizations can do to improve the “vaccine neighborhood” and improve relationships between providers
- Group, along with KDHE, will be focusing on an improved referral system (eventually) and highlighting good communication on social media/messaging.

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- Response from 80 out of 105 counties
- Overall, 91.1% of these respondents give vaccines
- Communication is good but can be improved. Concern that communication may fade post-pandemic
- Referrals remain an issue
